For something more intimate, Logan Square brewery Hopewell is hosting its own small-scale holiday bazaar December 15, with treats from Bang Bang Pie, craft beers and artisans like Charlotte Croy Hudson, Hello Paper Co., Lost Girls Vintage, and more.
